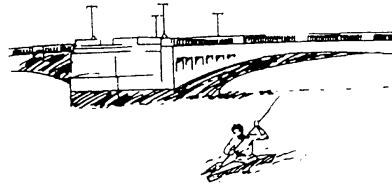

## **READING K1 ASSESSMENT RACE** **Saturday 23rd May 2009**

**VENUE** Reading Canoe club, The Warren, Caversham, Reading.  
Follow signs to Reading town centre, then signs for Caversham.  
Canoe Race signs will be seen near Caversham Bridge.

### **HASLER TROPHY**

This event counts as a Hasler qualifying event but points will not be awarded.

### **ENTRY FEES**

**Seniors £6.00, juniors £4.00 per seat**

BCU members should remember to have with them their BCU Thames licence, issued as part of their BCU membership. If you have not received your Licence then you must make sure you carry your membership card with you during the race.

All entrants must produce their BCU membership card at check in, no membership cards means you will not be allowed to race.

**Late entries will be charged an extra £2.50 per seat**

### **COMPETITORS SHOULD NOTE THE FOLLOWING:**

Please make sure that you indicate clearly the category you are competing in.

Juniors must be aged under 18 on 1st January 2009.

Team leaders should decide if paddlers under 16 years of age should wear a buoyancy aid.

**The Race Organiser has the final say on who has to wear a buoyancy aid.**

1. The Race will be run in accordance with the rules in the Canoe Racing Handbook 2009.
2. Vertical number plates must be used.
3. This is a River Thames race: Cabin cruisers and other craft will be frequently encountered. RULES OF THE RIVER MUST BE OBSERVED.
4. All entries must be received by Thursday 21st May 2009 otherwise a late entry fee will be charged.
5. BCU are to be shown on race day
6. RCC and its nominated officials cannot be held responsible for any loss of life, limb or equipment however caused.
